

CUMBRIA ROAD SAFETY PARTNERSHIP Road Safety Strategy Statement

1. INTRODUCTION

The primary aim of the Cumbria Road Safety Partnership (CRSP) is to reduce the total number of KSI's occurring in Cumbria year on year, its secondary aim is to reduce the total number of those killed or injured year on year.

2. BACKGROUND

The CRSP came in to being under the DfT national strategy: *Tomorrows Roads Safer for Everyone* in which it was recognised that the reduction of road casualties is the responsibility of several statutory bodies and that in order to be effective they need to work in Partnership. The CRSP has since evolved and provides an effective management arrangement for the planning and implementation of activities whose sole purpose is to reduce road casualties.

The DfT document Working Together to Build a Safer Road System: British Road Safety Statement of December 2015, sets out their vision, values and priorities in relation to British road safety.

3. STRATEGY

In order achieve its aims the CRSP will be intelligence led and will produce and implement Annual Road Safety Plans.
